### General Projects Description

The priority of the 2017 Ontario Regatta Team projects is to provide international level competition and training opportunities for Ontario's High Performance Athlete Development (HPAD) athletes and Ontario Development athletes. In addition, the projects will provide professional development opportunities for Ontario development coaches.

### Canada Day Regatta/Camp – June 30-July 7 & Canada Cup Regatta – July 8-9

#### *Specific Project Descriptions*

- Team size will be up to 50 athletes, including U21, U17 and Para athletes.
- Coaches are required to travel with the team on June 30 to July 9, 2017.
- All travel, accommodation, food and team gear will be provided.

#### *Project Duties*

- Coaches will be responsible for a discipline competition/training group for the project.
- Participating in all aspects of the projects (coach meetings, team meeting, etc.).
- Supervising athletes through all phases of travel, training and competitions.
- Coaches may be asked to mentor other development coaches during the project.
- Development coaches will work closely with one or multiple discipline coaches and will participate in all aspects of the project.

#### *Project Pre-Requisites*



- NCCP Competition Introduction (ELCC) certification or equivalent. Preference will be given to those coaches holding a minimum NCCP Competition Development 'Trained' status, or equivalent.
- Preference may be given to those coaches who have athletes nominated to the Ontario Regatta Team.
- Development coaches must also hold an NCCP Competition Introduction (ELCC) certification or equivalent. Preference will be given to those development coaches who have not participated in an Ontario Team tour or similar project.

### **Canada Summer Games – August 5-13\***

#### ***Specific Project Descriptions***

- Team size will be 20 athletes U21 athletes.
- All travel, accommodation, food and team gear will be provided.

#### **Female Coach:**

##### ***Project Duties***

- Responsible for a discipline group for the project.
- Participating in all aspects of the projects (coach meetings, team meeting, etc.).
- Supervising athletes through all phases of travel, training and competition.
- Participation during the Canada Day Regatta/Camp & Canada Cup Regatta is expected, however, arrangements can be made if the coach is unable to do so.

##### ***Project Pre-Requisites***

- NCCP Competition Development certification or equivalent.
- Preference may be given to those coaches who have athletes nominated to the Canada Games Team.

#### **Canoe Coach/Boat Driver:**

##### ***Project Duties***

- Responsible for a canoe discipline group for the project.
- Participating in all aspects of the projects (coach meetings, team meeting, etc.).
- Supervising athletes through all phases of training and competition.
- Participation during the Canada Day Regatta/Camp & Canada Cup Regatta is expected, however, arrangements can be made if the coach is unable to do so.

- \*Responsible for transporting boats and trailer from Ontario to Winnipeg and back (2100+ km each way). Boats must be in Winnipeg by Saturday, August 5 and can depart on Saturday, August 12.

#### **Project Pre-Requisites**

- Valid driver's license with experience in driving boat trailers.
- Experience coaching canoe athletes at the national level.
- Preference may be given to those coaches who have athletes nominated to the Canada Games Team.

#### **Compensation**

An honorarium or compensation for lost time at the club will be provided to the coaches. Development coaches will not receive an honorarium/compensation for lost time at the club as this should be viewed as a professional development opportunity for the development coach.

#### **Application Process**

All applicants should email their interest to Ryan Blair, OCSRA Technical Director. Applications must include a letter (email) of endorsement from your club indicating you are available for the project dates.
